## THE FELLOWSHIP

The Pharmacy Practice Fellowship at the University of the Pacific in Stockton, CA is designed for those with an interest in academia and pharmacy practice. This 2-year program strives to prepare fellows for a variety of practice settings and is accompanied by completion of a Master of Science (MS) in healthcare outcomes and clinical services.



## ELIGIBILITY

- Pharm.D. from a US pharmacy school (by August 31, 2023)
- Licensed or eligible for licensure in California (by August 31, 2023)
- Graduate school admission eligibility

## COMPENSATION

- Competitive Stipend
- Medical, Dental, Vision
- Tuition for MS programs

## HOW TO APPLY

Applications will be accepted starting November 15, 2022 for a September 1, 2023 start. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the two positions are filled. **Please see our website for specific application requirements.**



### TEACHING

Fellows will serve as part-time faculty members for required PharmD courses. They will be involved with leading patient case discussions, hands-on skills and patient counseling sessions, lectures, and more.



### RESEARCH

Obtain formal training to become an independent researcher through didactic graduate coursework and thesis completion as part of the MS in healthcare outcomes and clinical services. There are numerous opportunities to collaborate with other faculty and clinicians for additional research.



### CLINICAL PRACTICE

Fellows will complete 6 rotations, offered and chosen based on individual interest and site availability. Rotation options can include but are not limited to: long term care, Medicare Part D outreach, internal medicine, infectious diseases, critical care, and ambulatory care.
