Pre-Pharmacy Advantage Program

Set yourself up for success as you take the first step toward a career in pharmacy. From the first day, you will start building foundational knowledge and skills used by practicing pharmacists. Pacific's Pre-Pharmacy Advantage Program gives first-time freshmen the opportunity to complete their undergraduate requirements in the same environment as their doctor of pharmacy (PharmD) studies.

PATHWAYS

Earn your PharmD in as few as five years. Based on academic standing and preparedness, you may be placed in one of two pathways, completing your PharmD in five or six years.

Each pathway meets the PharmD program admissions standards for our pre-pharmacy students requiring a minimum overall 3.0 GPA and a 2.7 GPA in specific math and science courses, in addition to submission of an advancement application, an interview, a writing sample and background clearance. Successfully completing each of these requirements guarantees admission and extends students the opportunity to earn a blended bachelor of arts in applied science (BAAS) while in the PharmD program.

FIVE-YEAR

2+3

Two years of undergraduate study followed by three years of study in the professional PharmD program.

SIX-YEAR

3+3

Three years of undergraduate study followed by three years of study in the professional PharmD program.
